

## **TACRAO Strategic Enrollment Management Report**

### **SEM Committee Session Planning:**

The SEM Committee met at the 2018 TACRAO Conference in Ft. Worth and began the process of brainstorming ideas for session topics for the 2019 conference in Galveston. One of the key elements discussed during this time was building upon existing interest of topics and ideas being discussed at the current conference. Everyone seemed to feel there was a lot of “buzz” around certain topics like LEAN and leadership within enrollment management. Several of the committee members had already approached various presenters about doing so the next year. This made for a very fruitful and productive meeting.

### **2019 SEM Pre-Conference Workshop:**

Several ideas were discussed for the 2019 Pre-Conference SEM Workshop, but after some discussion, a unanimous decision was reached to bring Dr. Boyd Bradshaw, Associate Vice Chancellor for Enrollment Management and Chief Enrollment Officer at Indiana University-Purdue University Indianapolis (IUPUI). On July 16, 2019, the SEM Committee sent out a Call for Applications to the TACRAO Listserv for prospective Fred Russell SEM Newcomer Scholarship recipients.
