Aaron Alejandro is Executive Director of the Texas FFA Foundation located in Austin, Texas. In his non-professional hours, Aaron consults with businesses, organizations, education, and youth clubs



about ways to improve organizational and individual performance. He has more than 30+ years of experience in management, personal and professional training. As an inspirational speaker, his unique style of delivery transcends all age groups and corporate cultures offering a clear message of personal dynamics for success.

In his position with the Texas FFA Foundation, Aaron has established relationships with sponsors and individuals resulting in significant stakeholder engagement. With more than 270,000 students enrolled in agricultural science courses and Texas FFA membership with more than 170,000+ members, Aaron's efforts are bringing much needed "fuel" - in the form of sponsorships - to help make dreams come true.

Aaron coordinated and established the *Star Partnership* and *Convention Partners Program* which have established record levels of donor support. The **MYTEXASFFA** initiative includes a dynamic website (**MYTEXASFFA.ORG**) [which has an Emmy nominated documentary on the Texas FFA Foundation (*just click the "watch the film" link*)] establishing benchmark success for Texas agricultural science education and the Texas FFA – innovation in advocacy, engagement, and stakeholder connection.

In 2022, the Foundation recorded more than \$16 million dollars in endowment and financial assets. This amount represents a 400% net asset growth in financial support since Aaron joined the organization in 2000 ... in addition to the many leading-edge leadership development programs he helped establish. In the summer of 2022, fundraising records for the annual Texas FFA Convention were broken and new benchmarks set. Because of its success, The Texas FFA Foundation's development model is being used by more than 20 state FFA foundations.

In 2021 Aaron visioned and helped establish the professional nonprofit organization LEAD (*Leadership Executives of Agricultural Education / FFA Development*). The organization is made up of executives across the United States who serve in professional development roles to support agricultural science education / FFA. In addition to professional training, networking, and collaboration, the organization helps to recognize the success of development



officers and the critical role they play in providing the fuel to help make dreams come true for members of the FFA and the educators who guide them.

Aaron led the development of the LEAD Series for Texas agricultural science teachers and FFA members. A program geared to developing next level leadership skills through expanded professional networks, tours, sponsor visits, policy maker insights, and stakeholder engagement.

 LEAD Experience – affords 36 teachers (3 from each of the 12 respective areas) a chance to travel on bus for a week across the Lone Star State. Participants will travel approximately 1,000 miles visiting 14 locations and hearing from more than 50 presenters in agriculture, education, business, conservation, policy, and development. Legislative LEAD – open to all Texas agricultural science teachers, participants come to the State Capitol for a two-day learning experience. Provides an educational experience to help teachers better understand and engage in legislative, government and educational discussions. We empower our teachers to become the "trusted advisor" for their elected officials. In 2020, the Texas FFA Foundation received a grant from the Sumner Foundation to expand the Legislative LEAD program to Texas FFA members.

In April 2022, the Texas FFA Foundation launched the *Growing Our Future* podcast hosted by Aaron Alejandro. The monthly podcast features subject matter experts sharing seeds of greatness, professional insights, and strategies for personal and career success. 

Alejandro was appointed by Lt. Gov. Dan Patrick. Alejandro was selected based on the depth and diversity of his experience and impressive professional network. as well as personal and professional achievements. As a member of the Industry-Based Certification Advisory Council, Aaron will be in a unique position to advocate for career technical education and career technical student organizations.




vetted, social capital-driven network that helps every member make an even greater impact on the business world."

In 2011, Aaron played a small role in the feature film **Deep in the Heart**. The role put him on stage with Val Kilmer, John Gries, Elaine Hendrix and D.B. Sweeny. The movie depicts the true-life story of Mr. Dick Wallrath. Mr. Wallrath and Aaron have forged a great friendship. Wallrath is the largest individual donor in the history of the Texas FFA Foundation, donating millions in scholarships to help deserving Texas FFA members and making their academic dreams a reality. Between the Texas FFA and 4-H, Mr. Wallrath has invested more than \$30 million in Texas young people.



In 2012, Aaron added a new milestone to his career as a participant in the setting of a World Record. He was one of more than 850 people who participated in the La Quinta Mattress Human Dominoes which took place in New Orleans - breaking the previous World Record of 550 mattress human dominoes. Aaron was #381 in the World Record setting event. Aaron was in New Orleans participating in the La Quinta International Conference.



In 1983, Aaron participated in the American Legion Texas Boys State where he was elected Attorney General. One vote short of going to Boys Nation, Governor Mark White appointed Aaron to represent Texas and carry our state flag at National Flag Day Ceremonies in Baltimore, Maryland at the historic Fort McHenry. His duties required him to carry the banner of the Lone Star State and then join his country at 6:00 p.m. in pausing to say the Pledge of Allegiance (*Pause for the Pledge*) which is a national tradition happening on June 14 - Flag Day - each year. In 1986, Governor Bill Clements once again appointed Aaron (as President of the

Texas FFA) to carry the Texas flag, making him the only individual nationally to have represented their respective state on two occasions.

An avid sportsman, Aaron was featured along with Texas FFA President – Blake Vineyard on *The Prieferts*' television show seen on the Sportsman Channel. Aaron harvested an Aoudad sheep in the majestic Palo Duro Canyon. He supports conservation and best practices to ensure the longevity of our natural resources.
